ASSOCIATION SHEDS AND GREENHOUSES

If you have use of a site shed or greenhouse please keep them in good order by painting, repairing, replacing glass /polycarbonate panels.

BONFIRES

Last burning day on site is 25th March 2025. After this date if you cannot compost it take it home to dispose of. PLEASE do not leave rubbish on site for others to dispose of. (Council refer to this as Fly tipping)
Also please DO NOT put rubbish in the grass bins they

are for grass cuttings from the main driveways only.

PATHS, EDGES AND MOWERS

PLEASE remember it is your responsibility to keep paths and edges around your plot in good order, ensuring they are clear of anything that may damage mowers. Mowers can be borrowed (see a member of committee if you wish to use one). A donation for use of mowers will be most welcome as petrol and servicing of the equipment costs us £300-£400 a year. PLEASE return mowers after use, in good clean order and empty of grass. The committee are looking to provide a small shed with a combination lock this will enable plot holders to access a mower at all times,

RISK ASSESSMENT

The Committee do their best to ensure the site is as safe as possible and free from potential hazards. PLEASE also carry out a risk assessment for your own plot. Ensure there are no trip hazards, e.g. tools left on paths. Remove rubbish, don't leave sharp objects e.g. knives on your plot. Do not allow overhanging bushes and trees to encroach on the the paths.

TOILET

The toilet will remain open only if it is left how you would hope to find it. Please ensure children are accompanied by an adult when using the toilet as it is an expensive piece of equipment. The Red health and safety folder is kept in the toilet so that it is accessible to all. Within the folder is a page for reporting any accidents and a page to sign should you borrow a mower.

VANDALISM AND ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

If you are a victim of vandalism you must report by ringing 101, if you are threatened ring 999. If it isn't reported it isn't logged in other words it didn't happen.

MUD ON PINE STREET

Please clean your boots/tools before leaving the site this helps to keep neighbours on Pine Street on side.

SHOP
